Thanks! We've reached our goal for the building of the steeples on our church! Two larger donations came in from very loyal donors, and these put us over the top! How great it will be when they are finally complete and our steeples will be visible from a good part of the city, and lit up at night, they will show that the Church is present in Russia!

Hopefully we are near the completion of the steeple construction project. The Crosses for the top are now being manufactured in Vladivostok, donated by wonderful folks in Illinois, and the metal cladding for the spires is being done nearby in China. My fingers are crossed to get them done for February 2 and 3—two of our big feast days. I did the statistics on the steeple fund yesterday, and 40% of the collected amount is from Russians (which shows how anxious the Russians are to complete the steeples) 60% is from Americans. Thanks! We have been working on the church for 17 years already!
