I'm writing to thank you for your support. We are about in mid-summer with many folks on vacation, so your prayers and financial support are really appreciated! Now for the news!

Fr Vicky Samuel, C.J.D., led the annual kids retreat in Lesozavodsk again this year. The kids really look forward to it, and we do, too, because it is a good time to do some catechism with these poor children each year. Fr Vicky had to do it a little earlier this year because his Russian visa was set to expire. He has since gone back to Pakistan to get a new visa, and should be here by school time in the Fall.



We also had the joy on June 16 of celebrating the final solemn vows of Brother Jackson Malik, C.J.D., also from Pakistan. (See picture over) He is a seminarian studying in English in Pakistan, and plans to return to Russia after ordination. Yes, he was named for Michael Jackson by his father! His older brother is already "Michael". It is surely wonderful that we have these vocations from Pakistan working in Russia. We don't have any American vocations except Fr Dan and I. But the Pakistanis speak English as well as



their native language, and they have good formation as Catholics. And it seems fairly easy for them to learn Russian. Fr Vicky says, "I learned Russian from the kids!

It is parked on church land so that we don't have to pay for a parking space in the port, but we still don't have the keys because we haven't paid for it yet!
