Catholics in Russia which is travelling around to all the Roman Catholic parishes in Russia during this Jubilee Year of Hope 2025. It now has an even greater

meaning because the pope's earthly remains are buried very near to the original icon which is the main sacred image in the Pauline Chapel of the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome. **The pope chose to be buried there** because of his love for the Blessed Mother and his love for this historic

icon, which he would visit often, especially when he had to leave Rome for an international trip. Fr Dan had to fly up to the city of Yakutsk (3.5 hours flight straight north of Vladivostok) to receive the icon from the Salesian Fathers, and he flew back with it on a Saturday so that on Sunday he could give a talk about the icon before our two Sunday Masses, and then after masses we had the recitation of the rosary.

From Vladivostok the icon went to the Romanovka and Nakhodka parishes for the weekend; and then the next week it went to Ussurysk and Arsenyev. After that, our helper Nikolai Dorodnov took it to Khabarovsk and Komsomolsk by car. The event was a very good source of grace for our parishioners and a visible symbol of our unity with the universal Church.
