This month we held the **Far Eastern Catholic Youth Conference**. This is a very important time for all of us parishes of the Russian Far East when our young adult parishioners meet and have discussions and retreat. It was held in Khabarovsk this year. 30 youth attended, and ten priests, deacons, and sisters also attended. The theme this year was “In the Footsteps of St Paul.” They studied St Paul’s life and his method of evangelization, so that the young folks get the idea of how to work with their peers. Recently we celebrated the Feast of St Peter and St Paul, the founders of the Church of Rome. So you can pray to St Paul with us for the success of the Conference! We also spoke about NFP since most of the participants will be nearing marrying age. Just about every year, after the conference, somebody will think to become a sister or priest, so we pray for them, too!

I've been busy! I was the only priest here in the state for nearly a month for seven parishes! Two deacons were helping me. Russia is requiring foreign priests to leave every three months, so the rest were gone to renew their visas. Fr Dan and I are residents, so we don't have to leave, but he was in America for fund raising. Now Fr Vicky, Fr Marcus, and Fr Nikita are back, thank goodness!

Fr Sebastian is also here as a resident, but he has been in and out of the hospital for two months already, and needs blood work every other day. As usual, because of the war, there are problems to solve. And now is the time when we have to get ready for the new school year, and help with the brothers who want to be ordained priests (documents, etc.) Also, the bishop's secretary died, so
